FINAL ORDER

Ventura Utility Services, doing business as Simi Valley Sanitation Company, was authorized by Decision No. 83806 dated December 10, 1974 to establish increased rates on an interim basis. Other issues were to be resolved at further hearings.

By letter dated February 17, 1976 applicant stated it would not be proceeding with its application as the city of Simi took the plant over on August 21, 1975.^{1/}

In the circumstances, the Commission concludes that the interim authority granted in Decision No. 83806 should be made final.

1/ Decision No. 85843 dated May 18, 1976 authorized the transfer of the system to Simi Valley Sanitation District.

IT IS ORDERED that the interim authority granted to Ventura Utility Services, doing business as Simi Valley Sanitation Company, in Decision No. 83806 is hereby made final.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
