ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Applicant seeks authority to depart from the provisions
of Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (MRT 2) for the transportation of flattened
automobile bodies for Levin Metals, Inc. Public hearing was held
before Examiner O'Leary on October 27, 1975 and March 15, 1976.
The matter was submitted on the latter date.





By Decision No. 85585 dated March 16, 1976 the Commission
exempted flattened automobile bodies from the minimum rates
effective April 17, 1976. Decision No. 85585 was suspended as a
result of the filing of a timely petition for rehearing. The
petition for rehearing was denied on May 4, 1976, making the exemption
of flattened automobile bodies from minimum rates effective
May 15, 1976.

In view of the above the instant application is now moot and should be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 55666 is dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
