SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Horace Simmons, doing business as Vaca Valley Bus Lines, was given authority by Decision 73894 dated March 26, 1968 in Application 49923 to extend his passenger stage operations by transporting passengers and express from Suisun and Travis Air Force Base to Rio Vista.

Applicant's counsel notified this Commission by letter dated July 21, 1975 that the applicant seeks authority to abandon, and requests the Commission to revoke the passenger stage certificate for Routes 5 and 6 because passengers and express are no longer being transported on these routes. Counsel further alleges that Vaca Valley Bus Lines established the service to and from Rio Vista primarily to connect with Lincoln Bus Lines for a through service between Fairfield and Stockton and certain intermediate points. Lincoln Bus Lines is no longer operating its service. Consequently, Vaca Valley Bus Lines has not been able to maintain its connecting service.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate extension, and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

1. After the effective date of this order and subject to Ordering Paragraph 3 hereof, Horace Simmons, doing business as Vaca Valley Bus Lines, may discontinue service as a passenger stage





corporation between Rio Vista, on the one hand, and Travis Air Force Base and Suisun, on the other hand, and this portion of his certificate is revoked.

2. Appendix A of Decision 65585 as hereinafter amended is further amended by incorporating Second Revised Pages 1 and 2, attached hereto, in revision of First Revised Pages 1 and 2, respectively.

3. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall amend his tariffs and timetables presently on file with this Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

SECTION 1. GENERAL AUTHORIZATIONS, RESTRICTIONS, LIMITATIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS.

The Certificate hereinafter noted supersedes all operative authority heretofore granted to Horace Simmons, or his predecessors.

Horace Simmons, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the decision noted in the margin, is authorized as a passenger stage corporation to transport passengers, their baggage and shipments of express weighing 100 pounds or less on passenger carrying vehicles only between (1) Fairfield and Travis Air Force Base, (2) Fairfield and Suisun, (3) Vacaville and Travis Air Force Base, (4) Travis Air Force Base and Parks Air Force Base, \*(5), \*(6), and certain territories intermediate and adjacent thereto over and along the routes hereinafter described, subject, however, to the authority of this Commission to change or modify said routes at any time and subject to the following provisions:

- (a) Motor vehicles may be turned at termini and intermediate points, in either direction, at intersections of streets or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersections, in accordance with local traffic regulations.
- (b) When route descriptions are given in one direction, they apply to operation in either direction unless otherwise indicated.
- (c) No service shall be rendered to, from or between intermediate points from Travis Air Force Base to Parks Air Force Base.
- (d) No service shall be provided between the Cities of Vacaville and Fairfield.

SECTION 2. ROUTE DESCRIPTIONS.

Route No. 1. Fairfield to Travis Air Force Base

From Fairfield over North Texas Road and Travis Access Road to Travis Air Force Base.

Route No. 2. Fairfield to Suisun

From Fairfield over Union Avenue to Suisun.

Route No. 3. Vacaville to Travis Air Force Base

From Vacaville over Davis Road, Peabody Road, and Travis Access Road to Travis Air Force Base.

Route No. 4. Travis Air Force Base to Parks Air Force Base

From Travis Air Force Base over Travis Access Road, Interstate 80, State Highway 21, Interstate 680, Interstate 580 to Parks Air Force Base.

ALTERNATE ROUTE: Route No. 4, Travis Air Force Base to Parks Air Force Base

From Travis Air Force Base over Travis Access Road, Interstate 80, State Highway 4, State Highway 21, Interstate 580 to Park Air Force Base.
