OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Stockard W. Coffee, doing business as S. W. Coffee Trucking, requests authority to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 7-A in connection with transportation of silica sand, in bulk, from Ione and pulverized limestone, in bulk, from Bullard to the plant of the Glass Containers Corporation at Antioch.¹

The application is based on special circumstances and conditions detailed therein.

Revenue and expense data submitted by applicant indicate that the transportation involved may reasonably be expected to be profitable under the proposed rates.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of March 10, 1976. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant's proposal is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary.

The Commission concludes that the application should be granted as set forth in the ensuing order.


IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Stockard W. Coffee is authorized to perform the transportation shown in Appendix A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof at not less than the rates set forth therein.

2. The authority granted herein shall expire one year after the effective date of this order unless sooner cancelled, modified or extended by further order of the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

APPENDIX A

Stockard W. Coffee, doing business as S. W. Coffee Trucking, is authorized to transport silica sand and pulverized limestone, in bulk, from Ione and Bullard, respectively, to the plant of Glass Containers Corporation at Antioch, subject to the following conditions:

- 1) The charge for transporting silica sand, in bulk, from the plant of Owens-Illinois, Inc. at Ione to Antioch shall be \$4.00 per ton, minimum weight 26 tons.
- 2) The charge for transporting pulverized limestone, in bulk, from the plant of El Dorado Limestone Company at Bullard, to Antioch shall be \$4.50 per ton, minimum weight 26 tons.
- 3) Loading or unloading time in excess of one hour shall be assessed at the rate of \$3.00 per 15 minutes or fraction thereof.
- 4) Applicant has not indicated that subhaulers will be engaged nor have any costs of subhaulers been submitted. Therefore, if subhaulers are employed, they shall be paid no less than the rates authorized herein.
- 5) In all other respects, the rates and rules in Minimum Rate Tariff 7-A shall apply.
