


SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

It has come to the Commission's attention that the Steamship Catalina will not operate for at least a month. Additional service to Avalon and other points on Santa Catalina Island from San Pedro is needed immediately to provide transportation for the public. Decision No. 85938 dated June 8, 1976 in Application No. 55715, which provides additional service to Santa Catalina Island from San Pedro, has a twenty-day effective date. That date should be made effective today.
