SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 85723 dated April 20, 1976 granted Harbor Carriers, Inc. authority to increase its water taxi rates as requested. Applicant's evidence in justification of the authorized relief included projected increases in revenues from contemplated upward adjustments in water taxi rates applicable to vessels with twin engines of over 200 horsepower each but not over 350 horsepower each. Through inadvertence applicant failed to list such rates in its original rate proposal. By petition to modify Decision No. 85723 filed May 24, 1976, applicant requests authority to increase those rates by an amount previously found justified in Decision No. 85723. A statement of the present and proposed rates follows:

Where an additional crewman is requested or required, an additional charge will be made at the rate of \$30.00 per trip, per crewman added to the regular crew.

Where an additional crewman is required, an additional charge will be made at the rate of \$30.00 per trip, per crewman added to the regular crew.

If the increases sought by applicant are granted, it is estimated that additional annual revenues will amount to \$16,985.60. This amount is included in the revenue increase projected by applicant in Exhibit 7 of record in this proceeding.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Harbor Carriers, Inc. is authorized to establish the increased water taxi rates set forth in Table 1 hereof.

2. In all other respects, Decision No. 85723, in Application No. 55714 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
