ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By this application, Golden Sedan Service, Inc., a corporation, requests authority from the Commission to increase its passenger stage fares.

The staff of the Transportation Division made an analysis of the application and found that the results of operations information presented with the application was not of sufficient detail for the staff to evaluate the request.

Numerous telephone conversations have been held with the accountant, the attorney and the applicant in an effort to obtain the information for the staff to proceed with its study. In addition, several letters have been sent to the applicant asking for additional information to support its application. All of these efforts failed to produce this information needed by the staff to move forward with the study.

The staff of the Transportation Division recommends that the application be dismissed and that the carrier be ordered to charge only the fares published in its tariff on file with the Commission.

IT IS ORDERED that Application 55872 is dismissed, and applicant is ordered to charge only the fares authorized by Decision 75422, in Application 49376 issued March 11, 1972.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
