ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 84531 dated June 10, 1975, as amended by Decisions Nos. 84952, 85214, and 85650, applicant J. S. Shafer, Jr., was authorized to deviate from the minimum rates for transportation services provided by Griffith Company. That authority expires June 30, 1976.

Public hearings were held and the matter was submitted upon the filing of concurrent briefs due June 21, 1976. Final determination cannot be accomplished before the current authority expires. It is appropriate therefore to extend the present authority to August 30, 1976.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The authority granted by Decision No. 84531, as amended by Decisions Nos. 84952, 85214, and 85650, shall expire on August 30, 1976 unless sooner canceled, modified, or extended by order of the Commission.
