ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 85254 dated December 16, 1975, as amended by Decision No. 85651 dated March 30, 1976, applicant J. S. Shafer, Jr., was authorized, pending public hearing, to deviate from the minimum rates for transportation services provided for Corona Rock and All American Asphalt. That authority will expire June 30, 1976.

Public hearing is now scheduled for September 28, 1976 in Los Angeles. Final determination cannot be accomplished before the current authority expires. It is appropriate therefore to extend the present authority to December 31, 1976.
