Application of JET DELIVERY, INC. for authority to deviate from Item 150, MRT 2, 150 miles (0 to 25 lbs.) to shippers, as provided under the Provisions of Section 3666 of the Public Utilities Code.

OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Jet Delivery, Inc., a corporation, seeks to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 2 in connection with the transportation of general commodities weighing 25 pounds or less for distances between points not exceeding 150 miles.¹

The application is based on special circumstances and conditions detailed therein.

Revenue and expense data submitted by applicant indicate that the transportation involved may reasonably be expected to be profitable under the proposed rates.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of May 21, 1976. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant's proposal is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted as set forth in the ensuing order.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Jet Delivery, Inc., a corporation, is authorized to perform the transportation shown in Appendix A attached hereto and by

this reference made a part hereof at not less than the rates set forth therein.

2. The authority granted herein shall expire one year after the effective date of this order unless sooner cancelled, modified or extended by further order of the Commission.

APPENDIX A

Jet Delivery, Inc., a corporation, is authorized to assess the charge of \$5.50 for shipments of general commodities weighing 25 pounds or less for distances between points not exceeding 150 constructive miles, subject to the following conditions:

- Applicant has not indicated that subhaulers will be engaged nor have any costs of subhaulers been submitted. Therefore, if subhaulers are employed, they shall be paid no less than the rates authorized herein.
- 2. In all other respects, the rates and rules in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 shall apply.
