By virtue of the Commission's order the required tariff and timetable filings become effective July 3, 1976. July 3, 1976 will be the Saturday of the Fourth of July weekend. Applicant asserts its service is urgently needed on that weekend. In order to assure smooth service and accommodate holiday travelers on Friday, July 2, 1976, applicant needs to begin service on Thursday, July 1, 1976. Applicant asks that its tariff and timetable filings be made effective July 1, 1976. Applicant's request is in the public interest.
