ORDER SHORTENING TIME

By Decision No. 85938 dated June 8, 1976, as modified by Decision No. 85972 dated June 15, 1976, Harbor Carriers, Inc. was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a common carrier of passengers by vessel between San Pedro and named points on Santa Catalina Island, as specified. By virtue of the Commission's order the required tariff and timetable filings become effective July 3, 1976. July 3, 1976 will be the Saturday of the Fourth of July weekend. Applicant asserts its service is urgently needed on that weekend. In order to assure smooth service and accommodate holiday travelers on Friday, July 2, 1976, applicant needs to begin service on Thursday, July 1, 1976. Applicant asks that its tariff and timetable filings be made effective July 1, 1976. Applicant's request is in the public interest.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that applicant's tariff and timetable filings pursuant to Decisions Nos. 85938 and 85972 may be made effective July 1, 1976.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
