OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, HLH Trucking Company, Inc., a corporation, requests authority to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 2 in connection with the transportation of glass containers for Glass Containers Corporation from Antioch and Hayward to various points within 110 miles of said cities.¹

The application is based on special circumstances and conditions detailed therein.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of January 29, 1976. Yandell Truckaway, Inc., and O'Brien Freight Lines objected to the granting of the application but subsequently withdrew their protests.

Revenue and expense data submitted by applicant indicate that the transportation involved may reasonably be expected to be profitable under the proposed rates.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant's proposal is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted as set forth in the ensuing order.


IT IS ORDERED that:

1. HLH Trucking Company, Inc., a corporation, is authorized to perform the transportation shown in Appendix A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof at not less than the rates set forth therein.

2. The authority granted herein shall expire one year after the effective date of this order unless sooner cancelled, modified or extended by further order of the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
