ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 85534 dated March 9, 1976, we stayed the effective date of Decision No. 85141 to July 9, 1976 to permit the installation of individual leased line facilities in lieu of the general toll and switching facilities then being used to control Mohr's joint user radio system. The length of this extension was predicated on a written estimate from The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company (Pacific). A portion of the leased line facilities ordered from Pacific is to be provided by General Telephone Company of California (General). On June 21, 1976, Mohr received a letter dated June 18, 1976 from General indicating that it was not able to obtain all of the required equipment and complete installation before August 16, 1976. Mohr now requests that the effective date of Decision No. 85141 be further stayed until August 16, 1976.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the effective date of Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 85141, as it applies to R. L. Mohr's shared user system, is August 16, 1976.

As time is of the essence, the effective date of this order is the date hereof.
