ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Decision 84702 dated July 29, 1975 authorized Truman Tilley, doing business as Tiger Charter Lines, to sell and transfer his Class A Charter-party Carrier of Passengers Cartificate, which was in suspension, to Roland Wilbur. Ordering Paragraph 4 of the decision provided that the certificate shall remain in suspension for an additional period not to exceed six months. The suspension period was extended by Decision 85431 dated February 10, 1976 to August 18, 1976.

By letter dated June 10, 1976, Roland Wilbur requests a further three-month extension of the suspension period. The letter states that he is negotiating with a buyer, F. W. Wagener, III, for the certificate but that additional time will be required pending the outcome of the Commission hearing in Application 56350 for transfer of the authority.

We find that the request is reasonable and conclude that it should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The expiration date of the suspension of the Class A Charter-party Carrier of Passengers Certificate referred to in Ordering Paragraph 4 of Decision 84702 is extended to November 18, 1976 unless such expiration date is modified by further order of the Commission.
