THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

It has come to the Commission's attention that the mileage rates for over 150 but not over 160 miles for the transportation of lumber, lumber products and related articles, as authorized by Decision 85948 in the above proceeding were inadvertently omitted.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the necessary correction should be made by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Minimum Rate Tariff 2 should be amended accordingly and the effective date of this order should be the date hereof because the tariff publication should be corrected as soon as possible.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (Appendix D to Decision 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective July 31, 1976, Twenty-fifth Revised Page 51-CC attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject also to Decision 31606, as amended, are hereby required to establish in their tariffs the amendment necessary to conform with the further adjustment ordered herein.




3. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of this order shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the first day after the effective date of this order on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public.

4. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the amendment authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 461.5 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the amendment published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

5. In all other respects, Decision 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
