OPINION AND ORDER

Pullaro Contracting Co., a corporation, seeks exemption from the application of the minimum rates and rules in Minimum Rate Tariff 9-B in connection with the transportation of property, which because of size or weight, requires the use of low-bed equipment.

The petition is based on special circumstances and conditions detailed therein.

The petition was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of March 17, 1976. No objection to the granting of the petition has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that petitioner's proposal is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the petition should be granted as set forth in the ensuing order.
