## ORDER PARTIALLY SUSPENDING DECISIONS NOS. 85627 AND 86117

By Decision No. 85627, dated March 30, 1976, we ordered that, among other things, Southern California Gas Company (SoCal) refund certain monies. On July 13, 1976, we issued Decision No. 86117 wherein we essentially affirmed the action taken in Decision No. 85627. We now note that SoCal has sought a stay of our orders in Decisions Nos. 85627 and 86117 in the Supreme Court pending review of those decisions by that Court.

We have no objection to a suspension of the subject orders pending Supreme Court review of the challenged decisions. In order to facilitate this matter, we will suspend Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 85627, as modified by Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 86117.
