FOURTH ORDER EXTENDING TIME



Industrial Communications Systems, Inc. has, by petition filed June 22, 1976, requested a further extension of time beyond that previously granted by Decisions Nos. 82302, 82387 and 83758, within which to comply with provisions of Decision No. 81797, dated August 28, 1973, because of inability to reach agreement on a contract with Pacific Telephone. It appearing to the Commission that an additional extension should be granted, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the time for compliance with Decision No. 81797 is extended to and including December 30, 1977.
