## ORDER EXTENDING TIME

On May 12, 1976 by Decision No. 85754 we granted the petition of Southern California Gas Company to allow gas utilities to file tariffs, effective July 30, 1976, reflecting the end-use priorities established by Decision No. 85189.

As we noted in Decision No. 85754, we are cognizant of the extensive nature of the tariff revisions required by Decision No. 85189 and the need for a thorough review of the utilities' proposed tariffs prior to formal submittal. Because of the need for thorough review of the tariffs we will extend the effective date of the tariffs to October 31, 1976.

IT IS ORDERED that the effective date of the tariffs filed pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 85189 is extended to October 31, 1976.
