OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Clarence James Baker, doing business as Jim Baker Trucking, requests authority to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 15 in connection with the transportation of auto parts for-N.A.P.A. Distribution Center, Division of General Parts Company, by not assessing rates for premium pay hours.¹

The application is based on special circumstances and conditions detailed therein.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of June 18, 1976. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant's proposal is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted as set forth in the ensuing order and the effective date of this order should be the date hereof because there is an immediate need for this rate relief.

Under the proposal, the premium hourly rate of \$4.83 would not be assessed for each hour of service performed before 8:00 A.M. or after 5:15 P.M. on regular working days.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Clarence James Baker is authorized to depart from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 15 in connection with the transportation of auto parts for N.A.P.A. Distribution Center, Division of General Parts Company, by not assessing the rates for premium pay hours in Item 530 of said tariff for services performed before 8:00 A.M. or after 5:15 P.M., excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays. Such service shall also be performed in eight consecutive hours within a 24-hour period.

2. The authority granted herein shall expire one year after the effective date of this order unless sooner cancelled, modified or extended by further order of the Commission.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
