Application of Kings County Truck Lines for authority to charge less than the minimum rates heretofore established by the Commission, as authorized in Section 3666 of the Public Utilities Code of the State of California.

Application No. 56077 (Filed November 19, 1975; amended July 7, 1976)

FINAL OPINION

By Decision No. 85432, issued February 10, 1976, interim authority was granted to Kings County Truck Lines (Kings County), a highway permit carrier, under Section 3666 of the Public Utilities Code to assess less than the established minimum rates for transportation performed for Dairyman's Cooperative Creamery Association (Dairyman's), Tulare. Kings County was authorized to transport dairy products as described in Items 335.6 and 335.7 of Minimum Rate Tariff 2 from Tulare to Lucky Stores, Inc., Buena Park; Safeway Stores, Inc., Santa Fe Springs; Wilsey Foods, Los Angeles; or Jerseymaid Foods, Los Angeles; and return to Tulare with various supplies used by Dairyman's from origins in the Los Angeles metropolitan area. Kings County was also authorized to transport dairy products to Safeway Stores, Inc., Richmond, and Lucky Stores, Inc., San Leandro, with return loads from suppliers located in the metropolitan San Francisco Bay area.

The interim authority granted in Decision No. 85432 isscheduled to expire August 10, 1976. Decision No. 85432 ordered that
the effective date of that order would be extended only upon further
decision based on evidence that the authorized rates are compensatory.
The amendment to the application filed July 7, 1976 contains comprehensive cost data showing that the revised rates proposed to be
assessed, based on the number of trips per week when the assigned
tractor-trailer unit is utilized, will be fully compensatory.

In the circumstances the Commission finds that there are special conditions surrounding the proposed transportation services which will permit Kings County to achieve operating economies through the handling of full loads in each direction, that based on the data set forth in the amendment to the application the round-trip service can be performed at a profit, and that the proposed charges for round-trip services will be reasonable.

The Commission concludes that the authority requested in the amendment should be granted. The authority will be limited to a period of approximately one year inasmuch as transportation circumstances may change at any time.

FINAL ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Kings County Truck Lines, a corporation, is authorized to transport property for Dairyman's Cooperative Creamery Association, Tulare, at rates less than the established minimum rates, but not less than the rates set forth in Appendix A, attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 2. The authority granted herein shall expire September 30, 1977.
