ORDER DENYING REHEARING

In a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 85940 filed July 9, 1976, California American Water Company (CALWA) has requested (1) that hearings be held in accordance with Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 85940 for it and its customers in its Sweetwater, Coronado, Baldwin Hills, Duarte, San Marino and Village Districts, (2) that the Commission determine whether the instant proceeding involves a project within the purview of CEQA, and (3) that its Monterey Water District be exempted from the requirements of Decision No. 85940.

In Decision No. 36115, issued July 13, 1976, we suspended, in pertinent part, the order in Decision No. 85940 and ordered that a hearing be held, open to all respondents, in pursuance of the instant investigation. Accordingly, the instant requests made by CALWA with respect to the granting of a hearing and exemption from the order in Decision No. 85940, have been rendered moot. Insofar as local hearings in certain of CALWA's water districts, and a determination of the question of whether this proceeding involves a project within the purview of CEQA are requested, these are matters which should be addressed in the hearing in this matter and should be raised at the prehearing conference scheduled to commence on August 30, 1976.
