ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision 80746, dated November 21, 1972, in Application S3519, Jack L. Baker (PSC 919) was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between Pollock Pines, California and Mother Lode Drive (Old U. S. Highway 50) at its intersection with Pleasant Valley Road and points in between, all in El Dorado County.

By letter dated March 7, 1975, the Commission staff informed Jack L. Baker that it would recommend that his authority be revoked if he was not operating on or before July 31, 1975, the expiration date of the suspension period granted by Resolution PE-283 on March 25, 1975. Jack L. Baker has never resumed operations.

Since February 22, 1974, Jack L. Baker has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order 101-C.





It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation, authorized by Decision 80746, in Application 53519, is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Jack L. Baker are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The Executive Director of the Commission shall mail a certified copy of this order to Jack L. Baker at 5711 Sly Park Road, Placerville, CA 95667, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
