FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Douglas Bus Lines, Inc., a passenger stage corporation, operating under Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity granted by this Commission, requests authority to extend its "home-to-work" commuter services to two additional places of employment in the Los Angeles area. This authority was granted by Decision 85146, dated November 18, 1975. The authority was issued on a temporary basis, set to expire August 15, 1976, unless extended by further order of this Commission.


By Decision 86242, in Case 9630, dated August 10, 1976, the Commission extended Douglas' authority to operate its other passenger stage services until August 15, 1977, subject to certain conditions concerning vehicle maintenance and related matters. After consideration, we find that public convenience and necessity require a similar extension of the instant authority.


IT IS ORDERED that Decision 85146 is modified to provide that the authority granted therein shall expire on August 15, 1977

instead of August 15, 1976. This authority shall continue to be subject to all the conditions set forth in Decision 85146. In the absence of a further order to the contrary, this temporary authority shall continue in effect as a regular certificate of public convenience and necessity, effective August 15, 1977.


In all other respects Decision 85146 shall remain in full force and effect.
