Gunderson, co-partners, dba NILSEN CO., and LITTLE LAKE INDUSTRIES, a former California corporation, and/or AMCORD, INC., a Delaware corporation.

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On December 16, 1975 the Commission, on its own motion, ordered an investigation into the operations, rates, charges, and practices of Clyde H. Nunnemaker (Nunnemaker), dba Chub Nunnemaker Trucking, and six co-respondents.

On May 7, 1976, Nunnemaker requested the revocation of his radial highway common carrier permit. On June 8, 1976, Nunnemaker filed bankruptcy. Our staff advised that respondent Nunnemaker is no longer in California. In these circumstances, no good purpose remains for the continuation of this investigation.

IT IS ORDERED that Case No. 10020 is dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
