SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 86061 established General Order No. 139, effective September 1, 1976. Finding 9 of that decision provides:

"Each of the minimum rate tariffs, except MRTs 3-A and 4-B, should be amended to show that loss or damage claims must be filed and processed according to the provisions of General Order No. 139. For convenience, such tariff amendments should be made by separate orders."

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 10 (Appendix A to Decision No. 44633, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective September 1, 1976, Thirteenth Revised Page 2 and Seventh Revised Page 7 attached hereto.



RETURNED SHIPVENTS	
Articles refused by consignee may be returned to original shippers at original point of shipment at one-half of the outbound rate current at time of return movemen upon the following conditions only:	τ
(a) Goods for the return movement properly identified must be presented the carrier within ten days from the date that the outbound shipment was tendered to the carrier for transportation.	•
(b) All charges must be prepaid or guaranteed. Shipping order for the return movement must shown reference to original outbound shipment.	120
(c) Goods must be returned over the lines of the carrier that transported the original outbound movement.	
NOTEThe minimum charge specified in Item 90 does not apply in connection with return movements made in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this item.	
NUMBLING OF LOSS OF DAMAGE CLAIMS	
Claims for loss or damage shall be governed by the provisions of General Order No. 139.	*12
