## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 86061 established General Order No. 139, effective September 1, 1976. Finding 9 of that decision provides:

"Each of the minimum rate tariffs, except
MRTs 3-A and 4-B, should be amended to show
that loss or damage claims must be filed and
processed according to the provisions of
General Order No. 139. For convenience, such
tariff amendments should be made by separate
orders."

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 13 (Appendix B to Decision No. 55584, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective September 1, 1976, Third Revised Page 2 and Sixteenth Revised Page 7 attached hereto.

ACCESSORIAL CHARGES				
When carrier furnishes help in addition to the driver, an additional charge of (1) \$14.95 or (2) \$14.00 per man per hour shall apply. The time for computing the additional charge shall be not less than the actual time in minutes the helper or helpers are engaged in performing the services. The total time so computed shall be converted into hours and fractions thereof. Fractions of an hour shall be determined in accordance with the table provided in Item 80. See Item 360 for additional charges in connection with Volume Tender Service.				
(1) Applies when the accessorial service is performed in Territory "A" consisting of the Counties of Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bornardino, San Diego and Imperial.				
(2) Applies when the accessorial service is performed in Territory "B" consisting of all counties in California other than those included in Territory "A".				
MINIMUM CHARGE				
1. The minimum charge per shipment shall be that for two hours of service at the applicable rate. See Item 300 for minimum charge in connection with Volume Tender Service.				
2. When service is provided under the provisions of Items 60 or 200 on holidays, an additional charge shall be assessed for each driver or helper so furnished, as follows:  (a) On New Years Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day,				
Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day, twice the hourly charge in Item 60 for each hour worked with a minimum charge of four hours.				
(b) On Washington's Birthday, Good Friday, the day after Thanksgiving and December 24th, the hourly charge in Itom 60 for each hour worked with a minimum charge of four hours.
