Investigation for the purpose of establishing a list for the fiscal year 1976-1977 of existing and proposed crossings at grade of city streets, county roads or state highways most urgently in need of separation, or projects effecting the elimination of grade crossings by removal or relocation of streets or railroad tracks, or existing separations in need of alteration or reconstruction as contemplated by Section 2452 of the Streets and Highways Code.
