FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER


Decision No. 86087 dated July 13, 1976 in Case No. 9988 has been found to contain an error. The correct degree value for Climatic Zone No. 4 shown in the tables of quantities designated for unmetered units of multi-unit complexes in Finding 1 and in Ordering Paragraph 1 is 7,000 degree days rather than 7,500 degree days.




The Commission finds that Finding 1 and Ordering Paragraph 1 should be revised to substitute 7,000 degree days for 7,500 degree days where the latter value is shown for Climatic Zone No. 4.

IT IS ORDERED that Finding 1 and Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 86087 are revised to substitute 7,000 degree days for 7,500 degree days where the latter value is shown for Climatic Zone No. 4.
