ORDER EXTENDING TIME

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company (Pacific) by petitioned filed August 12, 1976, requests a 27-day extension from September 24, 1976 to October 24, 1976, to comply with Ordering Paragraph 1 and a four-month extension from six months to ten months to comply with Ordering Paragraph 2 of Decision No. 83405, dated September 4, 1974. Pacific states the extensions are necessary to complete the service offering and tracking studies ordered in Decision No. 83405.




The Commission finds that the proposed extensions are not adverse to the public interest, that the extensions should be granted, and that a public hearing is not necessary, therefore

IT IS ORDERED that Pacific is authorized to extend to October 24, 1976, its compliance with Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 83405 and to extend its compliance with Ordering Paragraph 2 from six months to ten months.

In all other respects Decision No. 83405 shall remain in full force and effect.

In view of the imminence of the original compliance date of Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 83405, the authority granted herein shall be effective on the date hereof.
