SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND CRDER

By Decision 20378 entered today in Case 5432, et al., the Commission found that courier transportation of "business records" and "medical specimens" should be exempted from the application of the minimum rates named in Minimum Rate Tariffs 2, 1-B, 9-B and 19. The Commission concluded in said decision that Minimum Rate Tariff 9-B should be amended by separate order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution.

IT IS ORDEDED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 9-B (Appendix A of Decision 67766, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective October 9, 1976, Second Revised Page 17-A, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. In all other respects Decision 67766, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

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
The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
