ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Pursuant to Section 354 of the California Public Utilities Code, Alwin Teuteberg seeks authority to acquire control of Pink Bus, Inc., a California corporation, through the purchase of all outstanding shares of stock of the corporation.

Pink Bus, Inc., a California corporation, is not a public utility but operates as a Class A Charter-party Carrier of Passengers within the State of California, primarily in Orange County and the immediate surrounding counties. Since Section 254 applies only to public utilities and no authority of the Commission is required to acquire control of a charter-party carrier of passengers, the application should be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 56582 is dismissed.
