## SUPPIEMENTAL ORINION AND ORDER

By Decision 85635, dated Marcin 30, 2976, we authorized Aztec Transportation Co., Inc. to transfer its highway common carrier certificate to Three-B Freight Service, Inc. on or before September 1, 1976.

A letter has been recelved from the applicants' attomey, requesting an extension of time to transfer the authority pending alsposition of an application filed with the Interstate Comerce Commission to transfer the comesponding interstate Certificate of Registration.

We will grant the extension sought. We also note that the scope of operating authonity deacribed in Appendix a to Decision 85635 inadvertentiy omitted the commodity restrictions contained in the transferor's certificate. In the circumstances it appears and the Commiscion finds that the necessary changes
should be made by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that the time imit for complying with the provision of Ordering Paragraph $I$ of Decision 85635 as extended to December 31, 1976 and that said decision $1 s$ further amended by substituting First Revise Pages 2 and 3 and adding Original Pages 4 and 5 of Appendix A in the place and stead of the original pages 2 and 3 of Appendix $A$.

The effective cate of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

3. Ifvestock, viz.: bamows, boars, bulis, butcher hogs, calves, cattle, cows, dainy cattle, ewes, feeder pigs, gilts, goats, heifers, hogs, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, rams (bucks), sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, stecrs, stags, swine or wethers.
