ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 85886 dated June 2, 1976, Trans-Aero Systems Corporation was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier between points in the San Francisco Territory.

Among other things, the Commission found that the operations authorized were required in interstate and foreign commerce. Applicant has advised that appropriate steps have been taken to obtain the necessary authority from the Interstate Commerce Commission. To date that authority has not been received.

Applicant requests that an extension of 120 days be granted to allow time for the filing of tariffs which will include the interstate operation.

Therefore, good cause appearing ,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Paragraph 2(b) of Decision No. 85886 is amended to read:
 - (b) Within two hundred forty days after the effective date of this order, applicant shall establish the authorized service and file tariffs, in triplicate, in the Commission's office.

2. In all other respects, Decision No. 85886 shall remain in full force and effect.
