The City of Santa Clara is the lead agency for this project pursuant to the California Environmental quality Act of 1970, as amended, and on June 30, 1976 filed a Notice of Exemption with the Santa Clara County Clerk which stated that the project was categorically exempt from the requirements of CEQA under Sections 15101(c) and (f) of the California Administrative Code, Title 14 (Natural Resources), Division 5. Reasons why the project is exempt were stated as: "There will be no physical change to the roadway or crossing and only the installation of safety equipment." Notice of the application was published in the Commission's Calendar on June 9, 1976. No protests have been received. A public hearing is not necessary. <u>FINDINGS</u> After consideration the Commission finds: 1. Applicant should be authorized to make public the private crossing of Yerba Buena Way at grade across the tracks of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company's Elmburst-Santa Clara - 1 ~

2. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.

This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if the above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
