OPINION

By this application Berleen Edmonds Chown seeks authority to control Bisher Truck Line, Inc. The corporation holds highway carrier permits and a highway common carrier certificate of public convenience and necessity acquired by the carrier pursuant to Decision 72232, dated April 4, 1967, in Application 49185.

A copy of the Judgment of Final Distribution In the Matter of the Estate of Lillian Eileen Edmonds, San Diego County Superior Court No. 100784, dated May 14, 1976, was filed with the application. By virtue of the Judgment, applicant inherited 1248 shares of stock of Bisher Truck Line, Inc., which, when added to the 180 shares already owned by her makes her the sole and only and, therefore, controlling shareholder of Bisher Truck Line, Inc.

California First Bank, the executor of the above Estate, delivered the certificate representing the 1248 shares which it had held during the administration of the Estate to Mr. Royse, the corporation's attorney on June 9, 1976 and he prepared to transfer the shares to applicant as of that date.

Notice of the filing of the application was made in the Commission's Daily Calendar of August 6, 1976. No protests to the application have been received.

After consideration, the Commission finds that control of Bisher Truck Line, Inc., by Berleen Edmonds Chown would not be adverse to the public interest.

The Commission concludes that the acquisition of control of Bisher Truck Lines, Inc., as requested in the application, should be authorized. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R


IT IS ORDERED that:


1. Berleen Edmonds Chown may control Bisher Truck Line, Inc., a California corporation.


2. Within ninety days after the date hereof, Berleen Edmonds Chown and Bisher Truck Line, Inc., shall file reports informing the Commission whether or not the stock acquisition has been completed.


The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
