ORDER DISCONTINUING PROCEEDING

Interim Decision 85786 of May 4, 1976, authorized Trails Trucking, Inc., a corporation, to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 2 by assessing a Class 65 rating, minimum weight 20,000 pounds, on shipments of potato chips in sealed foil wrappers in inner containers in boxes for Laura Scudder's Snack Foods Division of Pet, Incorporated.


A truckload rating of Class 65, minimum weight 18,000 pounds, was established on California intrastate traffic effective September 14, 1976, on potato chips in hermetically sealed cans or stacked one upon the other in cylindrical interior packing sleeves in boxes as set forth in Item 74480-A, Sub 1, of Supplement 7 to National Motor Freight Classification NMF 100-C. Inasmuch as the minimum rates for the truckload transportation of potato chips by all highway permit carriers are now based on the above truckload rating, there is no longer any need for the truckload rating authorized in this proceeding.



In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the authority granted by Decision 85786 should be revoked. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the proceeding in Application 56154 should be discontinued.


IT IS ORDERED that the minimum rate deviation authority granted by Decision 85786 is revoked and the proceeding in Application 56154 is discontinued.
