ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 84720 dated July 29, 1975 Preston Trucking Co. was authorized on an interim basis to deviate from the minimum rates for the transportation of beer from San Francisco to various points in southern California. Decision No. 85925 on June 8, 1976 extended until September 30, 1976 that authority.

Hearing was held March 23, 24 and June 17, 1976. The Commission has the matter under consideration and has not reached a final determination. It is appropriate under the circumstances to extend the present authority to December 30, 1976.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The authority granted by Decision No. 84720 shall expire on December 30, 1976 unless sooner canceled, modified, or extended by order of the Commission.

2. In all other respects Decision No. 84720 shall remain in full force and effect.
