ORDER OF DISMISSAL





The complainants request an order in the amount of \$3,284.89 from this Commission to fully compensate them for baggage which was checked with defendant at Los Angeles International Airport for transportation to Metropolitan Oakland International Airport. When complainants attempted to claim their baggage at Metropolitan Oakland International Airport, it was missing and not returned to complainants.

General Order No. 129 sets forth the limits of liability for lost baggage. This Commission, however, does not adjudicate damage claims under this General Order, consistent with our rule that we do not entertain complaints for damages (W. Schumacher v PT&T (1965) 64 CPUC 295). It is clear that complainants' recourse lies with the courts rather than the Commission.

IT IS ORDERED that Case No. 10133 is dismissed.
