ORDER DISCONTINUING INVESTIGATION

This is an investigation on the Commission's own motion into the application of Item 130 of Local Parcel Service, Inc., Local Freight Tariff 1, CAL PUC 1 (Tariff 1).

Tariff 1, effective September 10, 1983, provides rates and rules for the transportation of shipments weighing 500 pounds or less between points in the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Area. Item 130 "Shipments Tendered to Carrier's Location" of Tariff 1 was published under authority of General Order 147 to meet the rates and rules authorized by Decision (D.) 90744 dated August 28, 1979 in Application (A.) 58871 filed by Adams Delivery Service, Inc.

The interpretation and application of the provisions of Item 130 of Tariff 1 by respondent in connection with the package rates provided in Item 200 of the tariff does not appear to have conformed with D.90744.

Respondent canceled Item 130 from Tariff 1 by an amendment effective December 24, 1983.

We find that with the cancellation of Item 130, there is no further purpose in continuing this investigation.

We conclude that this investigation should be discontinued and that this order should be made effective on the date signed.

IT IS ORDERED that OII 83-11-04 is discontinued.

This order is effective today.


