O P I N I O N

After protracted negotiations, the Monterey County Superior Court issued a judgment in Carmel Riviera Mutual Wtr. Co v. Sawyer et al. (Case M 8685). That judgment, issued in August 1983, declares that the named mutual water company is the owner of the water system in question. It also restrains applicant Charles G. Sawyer from interfering in the operation of that system.

It is now indisputable that applicant has no ownership or possessory right in the water system. We therefore conclude that this proceeding is moot and should be dismissed.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that this application is dismissed.


