ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The complainants, Camp Meeker Recreation and Park Board and Camp Meeker Homeowners Association, have filed two similar complaints against defendant, Camp Meeker Water System, Inc. (CMWS).

A prehearing conference was held on November 3, 1982 to evaluate the issues raised in the complaints. After the prehearing conference, the Administrative Law Judge issued a ruling dated December 30, 1982 requesting CMWS to insert a newsletter in its next billing to customers. CMWS also was asked to list a business telephone number in the newsletter. The newsletter was requested so that the complainants will be informed on the status of the water system and the planned improvements to the system.


Since issuance of the December 30, 1982 ruling, the complainants have not requested further hearings on any of the matters referred to in their complaints and by letter dated November 13, 1983, the Camp Meeker Recreation and Park Board withdrew its complaint.

IT IS ORDERED that Case 11049 and Case 11055 are dismissed.

This order is issued under Public Utilities Code § 308 and Resolution A-4638.
