ORDER ADDING RESPONDENTS

By OII 83-11-05 dated November 30, 1983 and Decision (D.) 84-01-053 dated January 19, 1984 in this proceeding, we ordered that all "service suppliers", as that term is defined in § 44016 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, are respondents to this proceeding.

On January 19, 1984, we issued D.84-01-053 granting intercity long distance telephone service authority to the first four companies listed in Appendix A to this decision and we find those companies should be named respondents to OII-83-11-05.

As a result of responses to Question 10 of Attachment IV to OII 83-11-05, we find the other eight companies listed in Attachment A should be named respondents to OII 83-11-05. ✓

3. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of OII 83-11-05 on the respondents named in Ordering Paragraph 1.


