O P I N I O N

By this application, Cal-West Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent,
(Cal-West) seeks authority for Samuel J. Piazza & Son, Inc.,
(Piazza) to publish a "Special Trip" rule.

Piazza presently participates in the Cal-West Governing
Rules Tariff No. 300, CA PUC 3, and the proposed rule will be
published as an exception to this tariff.

The proposed "Special Trip" rule will provide an addi-
tional charge that would only apply when expedited service is
requested by the shipper or consignee.

Piazza has stated that the proposed application would not
increase its California intrastate gross revenue by as much as 1%.

This proposal is not considered to be a major action
significantly affecting energy efficiency within the meaning of the
Public Utilities (PU) Code Sections 3502.1 and 3502.2.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of December 22, 1983. No protest to the application has been received.

Findings of Fact

1. The increases resulting from this proposal are justified.
2. The following order has no reasonably foreseeable impact on the energy efficiency of highway carriers.
3. The proposal will result in increasing applicant's California intrastate gross revenue by less than 1%.
4. A public hearing is not necessary.

Conclusion of Law

The application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Cal-West Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, on behalf of Samuel J. Piazza & Son, Inc., is authorized to publish a "Special Trip" rule as an exception to the Cal-West Governing Rules Tariff No. 300, CA PUC 3 for Samuel J. Piazza & Son, Inc.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made as a result of this order shall be filed on or after the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than 5 days, after the effective date of this order on not less than 5 days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

This order becomes effective 30 days from today.
