Eugene Franklin Sylva III, doing business as Sylva Trucking, requests a dump truck carrier permit to operate in the Counties of Butte, Yuba, Sutter, Placer, and Sacramento. Notice of the filing of the application appeared in the Daily Transportation Calendar of January 18, 1984. No protests have been filed.

Applicant's place of business is at Oroville. He has one unit of equipment and will not lease equipment from employees or engage subhaulers. As of December 12, 1983, he had assets of \$209,000, liabilities of \$54,000, and a net worth of \$155,000.

A verified statement by applicant attached to the application shows that he has met the statutory residence requirements for a dump truck carrier permit. Also, a support statement by Bay Cities Building Material, Inc. attached to the application states that it will use applicant's service if the authority is granted.

#### Findings of Fact

1. Applicant:

- a. Is a fit and proper person to receive a permit to operate as a dump truck carrier.
- b. Has sufficient operating knowledge and financial ability to initiate and continue the proposed operation.

c. Has demonstrated that the privilege sought:

- (1) Will not endanger the safety of the public or interfere with the public use of the public highways or impair the condition or maintenance of them, directly or indirectly.
- (2) Will not unnecessarily burden the public highways.
- (3) Is necessary to serve the public and will not impair the ability of presently permitted dump truck carriers to provide adequate service at the lowest possible reasonable rates.

2. Applicant has resided in the State of California for at least the 90 days preceding the filing of this application.

3. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

4. The following order complies with the Commission's Energy Efficiency Plan.

5. A public hearing is not necessary. Conclusions of Law

1. Applicant should be granted a dump truck carrier permit authorizing operations within and between points in the Counties of Butte, Yuba, Sutter, Placer, and Sacramento.
