## <u>opinion</u>

By this application, Lewis E. Silvers, doing business as Lew Silvers Trucking (Silvers), requests authority to cancel his participation in California intrastate tariffs issued by Cal-West Tariff Bureau, Inc. (CWTB), and to publish his individual tariff. Applicant will publish rates at the levels he is authorized to charge in tariffs of CWTB.

Silvers believes he would be better served, for various reasons, by his individual tariff. Applicant alleges that due to inherent differences in the tariffs, certain increases and reductions would result. Silvers states that the proposal, if granted, would not increase his California intrastate revenue by as much as one percent.

The proposal is not a major action significantly affecting energy efficiency within the meaning of Sections 3502.1 and 3502.2 of the Public Utilities (PU) Code.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of March 8, 1984. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

## Findings of Fact

- 1. The increases resulting from this proposal are technical in nature and justified.
- 2. The proposal will result in increasing applicant's California intrastate gross revenue by less than one percent.
- 3. The following order has no reasonably foreseeable impact on the energy efficiency of highway carriers.
- 4. Authority to depart from the provisions of PU Code Section 461.5 is justified.
  - 5. A public hearing is not necessary.

## Conclusion of Law

The application should be granted.

## ORDER

- 1. Lewis E. Silvers is authorized to cancel his participation in tariffs issued by Cal-West Tariff Bureau, Inc., and to concurrently publish his individual tariff.
- 2. Tariff publications authorized to be made as a result of this order shall be filed on or after the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than 5 days after the effective date of this order on not less than 5 days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

- 3. Lewis E. Silvers, in establishing and maintaining the rates authorized by this order, is authorized to depart from the provisions of PU Code Section 461.5 to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.
- 4. The cancellation of applicant's participation in Cal-West Tariff Bureau, Inc., tariffs shall be concurrent with the effective date of his individual tariff.

This order becomes effective 30 days from today.
