O P I N I O N

Edward Flynn (applicant) filed the required form to request that his charter-party carrier of passengers permit be renewed (T.C.P. 1179-P). The Commission staff docketed the request as a formal Commission pleading and published the renewal filing in the Commission's Daily Transportation Calendar on February 14, 1984. No protests have been received.

Applicant only qualifies for a permit since he operates a single 1983 Cadillac limousine less than 20 feet in length. His terminal is located at 2948 Diamond Street, San Francisco.

We find that applicant is entitled to have his permit renewed, and we conclude that the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that the Executive Director shall issue a renewal of the charter-party carrier of passengers permit formerly held by Edward Flynn.
