ORDER GRANTING LIMITED REHEARING OF DECISION (D.) 83-12-057

A petition for rehearing has been filed by Zone 14 Motor Carrier Telpak Committee, California Trucking Association, and Di Salvo Trucking Company, Kings County Truck Lines, Lodi Truck Service, Smiser Freight Service, Smith Transportation Co., and Wallace Transport. We have considered each and every allegation raised therein and are of the opinion that good cause has been shown for granting a rehearing of D.83-12-057 limited to the issue of whether Pacific should be authorized to permanently convert from intrastate Telpak mileage charges to individual private line rates based on the January, 1984 comparison ordered in D.83-12-057, or whether Telpak services and channels converted to individual private channel billing may at a future date revert to Telpak services and billing. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that rehearing of D.83-12-057 is granted limited to the issue of whether Pacific's authorization to convert from intrastate Telpak mileage charges to individual private line rates based on the January, 1984 comparison ordered in D.83-12-057 is to be a permanent conversion.

Except as granted as provided herein, rehearing of D.83-12-057 is denied.
