ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Complainants Fred G. Labankoff, Labankoff Enterprises, Inc., Bevels, Ltd., and The Beveled Door Limited seek a judgment against defendant General Telephone Company of California awarding damages for its failure to provide adequate service, punitive and exemplary damages in an amount appropriate to punish or set an example of defendant, and for the costs of filing the complaint.

By letter dated March 16, 1984 to Administrative Law Judge N. R. Johnson from complainants' attorney, Gary H. Amsterdam, this Commission was notified that the parties to the proceeding have reached an "out-of-court" settlement and it was requested that the complaint be dismissed. The above letter further indicated that complainants' deposits totaling \$14,250.08 should be disbursed to defendant.

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. Case 82-09-06 is dismissed.
